STUDENTS' PERCEPTION TOWARD ENGLISH SONG AS A LEARNING MEDIA OF LISTENING COMPREHENSION

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Abstract

: Song is one of the teaching tools that is utilized to aid in the development of the English language. The use of song in the classroom has numerous advantages for the learning process. Therefore, this study was conducted to see whether using songs in the classroom can provide benefits in the teaching and learning process. This research was conducted on 6th semester students majoring in English at UNIMA. In this study, the researcher used a survey method assisted by a questionnaire instrument which was distributed via google form as a platform for conducting interviews with objects. The subjects of this study were 18 students in 1 class. Based on what was found in the research, students agreed with the help provided by the song in the learning process. Students feel that their listening skill has improved because of listen to English song, because spending time with listen to English song make them more familiar with the English word, also make it easier to memorize a new vocabulary in the lyrics. They also feel enjoy in listen to English song because listen to a song make the atmosphere of learning become more relaxing. In general, the students responded positively to the assertions, with the majority agreed. The usage of English song can be useful in developing listening abilities, as evidenced by the preceding explanation.

INTRODUCTION

English is one of the languages that unites all nations in current century. English is a critical skill that is highly recommended to master (Goni, Muntuuntu, Sanger, 2021). English as a foreign language has been studied by Indonesian students since they were

still in elementary school. English is very important as the key to international communication. Therefore, English is made a compulsory subject in schools. In learning English, there are two main aspects that need to be learned, language skill and language components. Language skill consist of listening, speaking, reading, and writing and language consist of vocabulary, structure and pronunciation (Lengkoan, 2017:218). In line with the School Based Curriculum, it is hoped that Elementary Schools school students to be able to speak and communicate in English. In this era of globalization, English has become one of the important compulsory subjects taught in school (Qordawi, 1991). English is the most widely spoken language in the world and every day millions of people speak English both at work and in social life. Most Indonesians study English as a foreign language in order to be able to communicate in English." (Maru, 2009), Therefore speak up important skills for students to master. English is utilized in almost every facet of life, from business to trade, academics, and tourism. It is said to be Indonesia's first foreign language (Mogea, 2019). Goals to be achieved achieved by students is the ability to express and respond simply teaching and information in the classroom context with the use of language functions. Such as giving instructions, asking and giving something, requesting and providing services, introduce yourself, invite, approve or disagree, praise, and congrats (Pikirang, Liando & Wuntu, 2021). It is expected that students can use language functions in real terms communication in their daily life. There are many kinds of strategies for teaching listening, one of them is use English songs. English songs are great fun, as well as good for teaching vocabulary and pronunciation (Djalaludin, 1999). There are many types of songs that can be used in the classroom, from children's songs to pop music. Nowadays it is very easy to find English songs, because most of our activity are using smartphone, and there are many platforms in the smartphone to find the songs we want.

One of the abilities that must be practiced when learning English is listening. Listening activities are also needed in the academic context, where students must understand by listening then give an opinion. Most of the students face difficulties in communication, and this problem lies not only in the students skill but also in the way

teachers teach, because students' interest in developing their skill depends on the way teacher teaches. So, teachers need to provide a more interesting learning methods, so that students have a great interest in practicing their skills. The purpose of this study is to find out students perceptions toward English song as a learning media of listening comprehension. The reason why the researcher chose this topic because by listening to English song people can train their listening to get used to listening to English words, so that slowly one can begin to understand what someone else is trying to say. This research delimited to students perception toward English song as a learning media of listening comprehension in sixth semester at English Education Department Universitas Negeri Manado that based on the questionnaire that given by the researcher to students who have experience using songs when learning in listening class.

1. Perception

Perception is the process of perceiving and processing sensory data in order to develop a mental image and grasp of things. A stimulus is sensed by an individual, organized, and then interpreted such that the individual knows and understands what has been sensed. Meanwhile, in the opinion of experts, Yusuf (1991: 108) call perception the meaning of the results of the observations. Pareek in Sobur (2003: 446) provides more definition perception, namely the process of receiving, selecting, 29 organize, interpret, test, and deliver reactions to sensory stimuli or data. According to Walgito (2010: 99), perception is a process which is preceded by a sensing process, viz is the process of receiving a stimulus by an individual through the sense organs or also called sensory processes. However the process does not just stop, but a stimulus is forwarded and the next process is perceptual process (Mogea, 2019). Therefore the perceptual process cannot apart from the sensing process, and the sensing process is a precursor to the perceptual process. Process The sensing will take place any time, at any time the individual receives the stimulus through the sense organs, through the eye as a means of sight, the ear as a tool the listener, the nose as an instrument of smell, the tongue as an instrument taste, and the skin on the palms as tools touch, all of which are the sense organs used to receive a stimulus from outside the individual

(Robbins, 2003). The sensed stimulus is then organized and interpreted so that the individual realizes and understands about what is sensed, and this process is called perception.

2. Song

Attempting to elaborate more on listening skills, according to (Lengkoan, 2017), "Listening is listening specifically and focused on the object being listened to. "Listening means listening with understanding and attention and appreciation, (Chaney & Burk, 1998). "Listening as a major process of listening to, recognizing, and interpreting spoken symbols." (Claerr & Gargan, 1984). "Listening is a process which includes listening to the sounds of language, identifying, interpreting, and reacting to the meanings contained therein." (Berne, 2004). During this research, speaking skill can be concluded that listening is listening to and understanding the contents of the listening material because it can be ignored that the main purpose of listening is to capture, understand or appreciate the messages, ideas, ideas implied in the listening material. Listening is a receptive type of spoken language skill. Thus, listening is not just an activity of listening but also understanding it.

3. Advantages by using song in the classroom

Song is an excellent 'tool' for assisting learners in learning English (Maru, 2009). Songs that are regarded to be useful to stimulate pupils when they are studying English in particular. Songs are also a crucial element of learning English since they increase pupils' sensitivity to sound, and learning languages is nothing more than learning various sorts of meaningful sound. Additionally, music might serve to make a lesson more engaging and energetic (Hampp, 2019). Doing various activities while listening to a song is a habit that many people have. For example, while working, studying, reading books, or driving, song has always been a loyal "friend" who always accompanies. (Tarigan and Tarigan, 1990), Especially in an era that is all digital like now, song is easier to listen to anywhere and anytime (Gibson, 1989). The multitude of streaming service provider platforms makes song even more accessible. You only need one touch

of a finger on the smartphone screen, you can listen to your favorite songs without having to buy or download. Even though it looks simple, listening to a song while doing activities has many benefits. The positive benefits obtained can have an effect both physically and psychologically. Song can slow down blood pressure, which affects the respiratory system. In addition, listening to a song also reduces tense muscles in the neck, shoulders, stomach and spine, thereby creating a more relaxed feeling. Listening to song with a good quality device, coupled with the strains of your favorite songs, can make your mood better.

4. The benefits obtained from song

- 1. Song can increase creativity and imagination.
- Song can enhance and teach other intelligence. Song has been found to increase mathematical reasoning, particularly abstract thinking skills in children, in a direct and consistent manner.
- 3. Song can stimulate memory. Songs are simple to access, contain real language, give vocabulary, grammar, and cultural information, and are fun for students. They can be utilized in and out of the classroom to help students improve their speaking, listening, and language abilities.

RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

This research was conducted in qualitative research. As Perreault and McCarthy (2006:176) said that, qualitative research is a type of research that aims to explore information deeply and openly on various responses. This research tries to get people to express their thoughts on a topic without giving them much guidance or direction. In this study, the researcher used google form as a platform in distributing questionnaires to subjects.

FINDINGS AND DISCUSSION

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The data in this study came in the form of the number of people who answered to each option in each questionnaire item. The responses were quantitatively analyzed in percentage using this formula:

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




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





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




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





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

Spending time with listen to English songs make me more familiar with the English words.



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





DISCUSSION

The use of English songs helps to teach students in an interesting way in terms of listening skills.
