Analysis of The Structure and Meaning of The Lyrics Song of Adeles 30th Album "Struggle of Love"

Abstract

Analysis of the Structure and Meaning of the Lyrics Song of Adele's 30th Album "Struggle of Love". Paper. Maumere: Faculty of Social Sciences Education and Humanities. IKIP Muhammadiyah Maumere. 2023. This research aims to know and explain the structures and the meanings of song's lyrics of Adele's 30th album. There are two focuses of research namely physical and inner structure and meaning. The method of research used descriptive qualitative. In this research, there are two data sources, namely: primary and secondary data. For data collection, the researcher used interpretation of written material according to published notes, and articles. Based on the researcher conducted by the researcher, some important things can be found it, namely Adele's songs contain a lot of structure and meaning. The results of the analysis found that in Adele's song especially in 30th album, there are two big points. The points are: structure and meaning. The physical structure of Adele's songs contains a lot of diction, figurative language, and imagery, basically that of the seventh mostly used three important parts of the physical structure. In terms of the inner structure of Adele's songs there are important elements in them namely: themes, tones, feeling and mandate that are so diverse and aesthetically pleasing. Basically, of all that song that exist, not all song contains important points in the inner structure but only a few songs.

INTRODUCTION

Language is an ability of a person to communicate with others by using signs and symbols for example: words and gestures. According to Kridalaksana and Djoko Koentjono (in Chaer, 2014:32), language is system of arbitrary sound symbols used by members of social groups to work together, communicate, and identify themselves. The form of research on language is through a scientific study called linguistic. According to (Siminto, 2013, P.4), linguistics is the study of the intricacies of language or linguistics. Linguistic is the science of language and external linguistic. Internal linguistics consists of phonology, morphology, syntax and semantics, while external linguistics includes sociolinguistics, psycho-linguistics, ethno-linguistics (Alwasikh, 1987:87).

In this research, the researcher is going to analyze the structure and meaning of semantic. Semantic is the research of the "toolkit" for meaning; knowledge encoded in the vocabulary of the language and in its patterns for building more elaborate meanings, up to the level of sentence meanings (Griffiths, 2006: 1). It is realized and cannot be denied that the language of songs has become an inseparable part in every background of human life. Song lyrics are an arrangement or series of words that are pitched (Awe, 2003:12), Song lyrics are a person's expression regarding something that is difficult to see, hear or experience.

The word song has the meaning of various rhythmic sounds (Moeliono, 2003:624). The song (singing) is the result of the relationship between the art of sound and the art of language, as a work of sound art that involves the melody and the color of the singer's voice. Song is an artistic composition of tones or sounds in sequence, combination, and temporal relationship to produce a musical composition that has unity and continuity. And a variety of rhythmic tones or sounds are also called songs. Song can be sung solo, two, three or in groups.

Song structure is the arrangement of musical elements in a song which produces a meaning. Song lyrics can also contain the outpouring of someone's hearts feeling which are turned into words that convey special meaning. The same way the song can give some impacts in increasing someone's speaking skill especially "pronunciation" (Saun Lolong, 2019: 5).

In this study the researcher realizes the importance of song lyrics, one of which is to give insight into speaking skill. The point is the song must have its own and different structure and meaning. The researcher prefers Adele's 30th album "Struggle of love" for its own reasons, namely the uniqueness and the diction which are used by the poet is very beautiful which convey different nuance from other songs. The songs' lyrics that the researcher examine in Adele's 30th album are, My little love, I drink wine, Easy on me, Woman like me, Love is game, Cry your heart out, Can I get it.

The most basic reason in this research is that Adele's 30th album songs are very romantic and the diction of the words or sentences which are used also very good. As stated by one of the authors (Deka betari 2022: 250); on Adele's album 30th there is a style of language comparison that are indeed use strengthen the meaning of the songs that are made. Comparative language style itself a sentence or expression that hidden meaning that is different from the true meaning. Therefore, those songs are worth for researcher to examine and besides that there is a purpose to know more deeply regarding the structure and meaning of songs' lyrics on Adele's 30th album.

REVIEW OF LITERATURE

A. Theoretical Background

1. Song

According to Indonesian Dictionary (KBBI), song is a rhythmic variety of sounds (in speech, singing, reading, and so forth), In the other hand, according to Merriam Webster Dictionary, song is defined as the act or art of singing, a poetical composition which characterized by sound or series of sounds (Merriam Webster Dictionary, 1828). But above said definition is not able to elaborate the wholeness the meaning of song.

In Kristyanti, song is understood as school of words which are composed beautifully which is sung accompanied by musical instrument (Kristyanti, 2012: 12). In line with

(Kristyanti, Moeliono 2003), understands song as a work of art relating to sound and language art as a sound work involves the melody and the color of the voice. Words of song have a rhythmic variety of voice (Moelino in Peny, 2003:624). Based on the foregoing view, it may be concluded that a song is a form of expression that is expressed by a writer or poetic script and is conveyed to the accompaniment of tone, rhythm, and beauty. A song in addition, provides fun and entertainment and in the same way provides an imaginary message. The words of the song have two meanings, in Moeliono (2007:628), explained as a follow, the lyrics of a song as literary work in a poem that contains brooding, as a hymn. To use a lyric a poet must be good at processing words.

2. Song Lyrics

The words of a song have the meaning various rhythmic sounds (Moelino 2007:624). The lyrics of the song are the result of a combination of language art and sound art, as works of sound involved the color of the singer's voice and melody. From the foregoing opinion it can be concluded that the lyrics of a song are an artistic work of combining words, aesthetic art and sounds, or melodies, in terms of melody and sound.

3. Structure of Song

The poem (the lyric of the song) consists of two large of the physical structure and inner structure. Richards (in Djojosuroto, 2006), said that two elements they are the method of poetry or lyric song and the nature of poetry or lyric song where is the Balton (in Djojosuroto, 2006) refer to it as a mental and physical form. Physical structure simply called language, where the inner structure is simple called meaning. The physical structure of song lyrics is constructed by diction, the figurative language, and imaging. On the one hand, the inner structure is constructed by the tree thoughts, themes, tones, feeling and mandate.

4. Structure of Song Lyrics

The physical structure of song lyrics is conducted by diction, figurative language, and physical imaging

a. Diction (words selection)

Words selected must consider the meaning, composition of the sound in the form the rhythm, word composition and aesthetic value contained in the song lyrics. The choice of words is also very much determined by the type of song lyrics made. Diction is the essence of writing song lyrics and the determining factor the ability of the poet's creativity in making song lyrics (Sayuti, 2010: 143-144). The arrangement of words is very important in order to grow poetic atmosphere that will read the reader or listener on understanding and full enjoyment. In addition, Abraham in Wiyatmi (2008: 63), explain that diction is the choice of words or phrases in a work literature. Overall that diction or the use of words in a song lyric is very important because it can provide a clear meaning and can be understood by listeners in particular. According to Chaer (2009:65), differences in diction based on denotative and connotative meanings correspond to the presence or absence of sense of value in a word. Denotative meaning is diction with the actual meaning of a word or sentence. In other words, the denotative meaning is an objective meaning without carrying a certain or pure feeling. While the connotative meaning is diction, words or sentence that do not actually mean. Connotative meaning can also be interpreted as a figurative meaning related to the value of feel

b. Figurative Language.

Figurative language used by Peot to express something in a direct way so, the words used have a figurative or symbolic meaning. As said by Sudjiman in Hasanuddin (2002: 98), explains that language (figureative) is a language that uses words that are structured and meaning deliberately deviated from the usual arrangement and meaning, with the aim of get freshness and power of expression. According to Hassanudin (2002: 133), how to use figurative language, namely by making use of comparisons, contradiction, linkage, between one thing and another, which the meaning is already known by the reader or listener. Figurative language emits a lot of meaning or rich in meaning. This figurative language is also known as figurative language.

According Andre K. (2020), figurative language has various types. Figurative language is divided into four types, each of which has it own function. There are four kinds of figurative language, namely: comparative figurative language, contradictory figurative language, satirical figurative language and assertive figurative language.

- Comparative figurative language is figure of speech whose style of language is expressed by juxtaposing or comparing an object with another object. Some kinds of comparative figurative language:
 - a) Personification is figurative language use to replace the function of inanimate object that can behave like human. Example: the night wind has prevented me from going outside.
 - b) Metaphor is language style used a figurative of speech expiate represent another meaning based on similarities or comparisons. Example: his business went bankrupt because he had debts with loan sharks.
 - c) Euphemism is a style of language in which words that are considered unfavorable are replaced with more subtle equivalents. Example: he was caught in a corruption case, he had to be brought to justice.
 - d) Simile is style of language that juxtaposes on activity with an expression. Example: the little boy cries like a chick that has lost its mother.
 - e) Allegory is figurative language that juxtaposes an object with a figurative word or sentence. Example: finding the perfect woman is like looking for needle in a haystack.
 - f) Symbolic is language style with expressions that compare humans with attitude of other living things. Example: a woman is indeed docile.
 - g) Association is figurative language that compares two different objects. Example: the faces of the father and son are like halved betel nut.
 - h) Hyperbola is style of language that express something excessively, even seem absurd. Example: the man has a hard spirit like steel, of course he will be a successful person.
- 2. Contradictory figurative language is language style in literary works that uses figurative language, where the meaning is the opposite of the actual meaning.
 - a) Litotes is an expression like self- depreciation even though in reality it is quite the opposite. Example: please stop by our humble hurt.
- 3. Satirical figurative language is a style of language that uses figurative words with the aim of someone, behavior and a condition.

- a) Cynicism is style of language in which someone gives direct satire t another person. Example: your room so dirty that dust is scattered everywhere.
- b) Sarcasm is style of language use to satirize other people with a hash connotation. Example: you are incompetent! If you can't work you will just be the trash of society.
- 4. Assertive figurative language is language style to state something emphatically in order to increase understanding and impress to reader or listener.
 - a) Repetition is figurative language that repeat words in a sentence. Example: the man was the pickpocket, he was the culprit, he was the one who took my wallet.
 - b) Rhetoric is style of language in the form of a question sentence but actually don't need to be answered. Example: if you pray at dawn every time?
 - c) Parallelism is style of language that repeats a word to emphasized the meaning of the word in several different definitions. Example: love is patient. Honey is gentle. Love forgives.
- c. Imaging.

Imaging is the use of words in poetry (song lyrics) can affect sensory experiences such as sight, hearing, and feeling. The lines in the song lyrics are as if contains echoes of sound (auditive images), as if seen (visual images), or as if it can be touched or felt (tactile imagery). As said by Jaborim (2003: 36), that the image is wishful images, thought images, mental impressions or visual images and the language the describes it. In his book stylistic (2012: 20-25). Sutejo states that dividing the image into five parts: sight, hearing, olfactory, touch, and movement.

1. Inner Structure of Song Lyrics

The inner structure is constructed by the tree thoughts, themes, tones, feeling and mandate.

a. Themes

Theme is the main idea expressed by the poet through the song (Finoza 2008: 215). reader or listeners must a least known the background of the poet, so that do not misinterpret the themes of the song's lyrics. Therefore, the theme that specific (referred to form the poet), objective (all readers must interpret the same), and straightforward (not a figurative meaning taken from the connotation).

b. Tones

The tone in the song lyrics can be expressed the poet's attitude towards the reader or listener. Djojosuroto (2005: 26) adds that the readers appreciation of the tone expressed by the poet must be right. Only in this way the interpretation of the meaning of a song lyric can be approached accuracy as desired by the poet.

c. Feelings

Djojosuroto (2006: 26), explain the poetry (song lyrics) expresses poet's feelings. Song lyrics can express feelings of joy, sadness, touched, afraid, anxious, longing, curious, hate, love, revenge, and so on. The feelings expressed by the poet are total, meaning that they are not half-hearted. Therefore, the poet mustered all the strength of his language to strengthen the overall expression of feelings.

d. Mandate

The message that will be convey by the poet can be examined after understand the theme, feel, and tone of the song's lyrics. The mandate is a thing that encourage poets to create their own poetry. The message is implied behind the words which are arranged in such a way, and are behind the themes that are expressed.

B. Meaning of Lyric Song

The meaning of the song is a phrase or the meaning of the song. The meaning or message of the lyrics in a song is to tell the listener good or bad things about an event in everyday life. The meaning of the song is an expression or meaning f a song.

To find the meaning of the message in the song lyrics, the semiotic method is used which incidentally is a field of science that studies the sign system. According to Van Zoest (in Sobur, 2001:96) defines semiotics as "the science of signs and everything related to them: how the function, their relationship with other words, their delivery, and their reception by those use them". Starting from how the sign is interpreted, influence by perception and culture, followed by how the sign helps humans interpret the surrounding situation.

In doing the meaning should not be arbitrary, but based on a semiotic framework (science /sign system) because literature is sign system or semiotics (Pradopo, 2009: 120-121). To understand song lyrics and give meaning to song lyrics is not easy without understanding literary conversion. Song lyrics work of art with a medium language. Song lyrics must be understood as a sign system (semiotic).

METODE

The study is much more concerned about qualitative than quantitative. The qualitative approach was chosen because the data obtained in the form of descriptive data focuses on actual problems as they were at the time research took place. According to Moleong (2007), qualitative research is research conducted to understand social phenomena from the perspective of the perpetrators. Qualitative research is research that focuses on analysis, qualitative research also involves anthology activities. The data concluded are in the form of words or picture that have a more meaningful meaning and are able to trigger a more real understanding than just the presentation of numbers or frequencies.

Sources of Data

Data sources are divided into two, namely primary data and secondary data. Primary data is data obtained by researchers directly (first hand), while secondary data is data obtained by researchers from existing sources (Syinen, 2015). So, the primary data in this research is consist some transcripts from lyric songs and the secondary data in this study are sources from the internet and published document or data in order to obtained further information on a song lyric.

Technique of Data Collection

This study prioritizes the interpretation of written material according to the context presented. The material obtained are in the form of published notes, manuscripts, article and other similar materials. Which is the focus of the intended data source, namely published notes and articles. The steps in data collection used

by researcher are researcher looking for and finding the song's lyrics they are looking for presented on internet, especially being able to find songs from Adele's 30th album studied, read the sources obtained, then identify the lyrics songs and then the researcher must be having divided which parts includes in structure (physical and inner structures) and meaning

Analisis data

The technique of analysis used in this research is technique descriptivequalitative content. This technique is used because the data qualitative in the form of language building and its meaning. Activity this analysis includes listening, reading, recording data, rereading identifying data, classifying data discussing data, presenting data, and inference withdrawal. Content Analysis is a qualitative is a qualitative research technique by emphasizing the constancy of the content of communication, the meaning of the contents of the symbolic interactions that occur in communication (Bungin, 2011).

Therefore, the researcher uses the hand phone as media to find the lyrics of the song to be studied, especially Adele's songs on the 30th album. Next, the researcher listens it, write it down in a small note, and star to analyze it, especially finding words or sentence that are included in terms structure and meaning. For example, researcher able to divide words or sentence in Adele's 30th album "struggle of love" in physical structure: diction, figurative language, imaging. And in inner structure: themes, tones, feelings, and mandate. And in the meaning section researcher must be able to give the meaning of lyrics song of Adele's 30th album "struggle of love"

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Results

Adele Laurie blue Adkins or better known as Adele was born on May 5, 1988 in Tottenham, England. She is a singer from England. One of her famous songs is someone like you. Adele started her career in 2006. She signed a contract with XL recordings, a British record producer, in September 2006. Adele was released under the title "19, this album was the first step for Adele's to become widely known to the world community. Evidently, in 2009 he won the grammy awards for "best newcomer" and "best pop vocal performance". On October 13, 2021 Adele confirmation the title of her fourth album would be 30, which released on November 19, 2021, (Cunningham, 2023). Albums 30th tells the story of her divorce from ex-husband, Simon Konecky after three years of marriage. Not only about separation, album 30th is like a letter addressed by Adele to her son, Angelo, explaining the reasons why her father no longer lives with them.

Structure

Based on the data analysis, the researcher has found two important points in Adele's song especially in 30th album namely: physical structure and inner structure.

A. Physical Structure

There are three important points in physical structure namely: diction, figurative language, and imaging.

a) Themes

Discussion

A. Structure

a. Physical Structure

In terms of physical structure have divided in three points, namely: diction, figurative language, imaging.

a) Diction

Diction is the essence of writing song lyrics and the determining factor the ability of the poet's creativity in making song lyrics (Sayuti 2010:143-144). The arrangement of words is very important in order to grow poetic atmosphere that will read the reader or listener on understanding and full enjoyment. Diction based on its meaning is still divided into 2 types, including denotative meaning and connotative meaning. According to Cheer (2009: 65), differences in diction based on denotative and connotative meanings correspond to the presence or absence of sense of value in a word. Denotative meaning is diction with the actual meaning of a word or sentence. In other words, the denotative meaning is an objective meaning without carrying a certain or pure feeling. While the connotative meaning is diction, words or sentence that do not actually mean. Connotative meaning can also be interpreted as a figurative meaning related to the value of feel. As explained by the Cheer that what is the benchmark for diction is connotative and denotative, in Adele's song especially in 30th album, all the songs have these two important parts.

b) Figurative Language

As said by Sudirman in Hasan Uddin (2002: 98), explains that language (figurative) is a language that uses words that are structured and meaning deliberately deviated from the usual arrangement and meaning, with the aim of get freshness and power of expression.

Figurative language is divided into four types, each of which has its own function. There are four kinds of figurative language, namely: comparative figurative language, contradictory figurative language, satirical figurative language and assertive figurative language. (Andre. K. 2020). As said by Andre K. this is true because where from Adele's songs all of these songs have the 4 components of the figurative language, but not all songs have all the parts of these components.

c) Imaging

As said by Jaborim (2003: 36), that the image is wishful images, thought images, mental impressions or visual images and the language the describes it. In his book

stylistic (2012: 20-25). Sutejo states that dividing the image into five parts: sight, hearing, olfactory, touch, and movement.

On the sevens songs, especially Adele's 30th album, only 4 important parts of imaging, 5 parts should be, but in Adele's songs, especially the olfactory part, is not found in Adele's songs.

b. Inner Structure

a) Themes

Theme is the main idea expressed by the poet through the song (Finoza 2008: 215). On the seven songs by Adele, especially on her 30th album, all of them have the theme of the struggle to maintain a love affair that is currently aground. All the themes raised are based on what Adele herself is feeling or is currently experiencing.

b) Tones

The tone in the song lyrics can be expressed the poet's attitude towards the reader or listener. (Djojosuroto (2005: 26). The tones contained in Adele's songs, especially Adele's 30th album, are all classified as medium tones, all of which correspond to the types of sound that Adele herself has and the chord voice from Adele's A3 - A5. Basically, to create a song the first thing you have to do is adjust the type of sound that is there, so that the tones created are harmonious. Adele herself has a mezzo soprano (Andre K. 2021) voice type (a tone that is in the medium tone), automatically all the tones in Adele's song are classified as medium tones.

c) Feeling

Djojosuroto (2006: 26), explain the poetry (song lyrics) expresses poet's feelings. Song lyrics can express feelings of joy, sadness, touched, afraid, anxious, longing, curious, hate, love, revenge, and so on.

Based on the research studied, the researcher found, in particular, the "feel" of Adele's 30th album namely sadness, anxious, and love. It was all proven through Djojosuroto but not all of it was in addles song.

d) Mandate

The mandate is a thing that encourage poets to create their own poetry. (Suryono. 2015). In fact, of all songs on the 30th album focuses more on mandates for three individuals, namely: Adele: does not want to repeat the same relationship, her son: must be patient in accepting the wounds has suffered and her husband: able to love a woman sincerely.

B. Meaning of the Lyrics Songs

The meaning or message of the lyrics in a song is to tell the listener good or bad things about an event in everyday life. The meaning of the song is an expression or meaning of a song.

To find the meaning of the message in the song lyrics, the semiotic method is used which incidentally is a field of science that studies the sign system (Van Zoest (in Sobur, 2001:96).

On the seven songs based on the lyrics of the songs contained in Adele's songs can be presented are concluded based on her life background and also defined studied that the sevens songs contained in Adele's 30th album have the meaning of

a mother struggles for love so great for her children and husband but not according to reality.

CONCLUSION

Based on the result of the research and discussion of the data from the research, it can be concluded that in Adele's song especially in 30th album, there are two big points in it. These points are: structure and meaning. In terms of structure, especially the physical structure and inner structure of Adele's song there are so many of them.

The physical structure of Adele's songs contains a lot of diction, figurative language, and imagery, basically that of the seventh mostly used three important parts of the physical structure. In terms of the inner structure of Adele's songs there are important elements in them namely: themes, tones, feeling and mandate that are so diverse and aesthetically pleasing. Basically, of all that song that exist, not all song contains important points in the inner structure but only a few songs. In terms of the meaning of Adele's song, they contain quite a lot of deep meanings and are quite difficult to define. Over all, Adele's songs contain quite a lot of structure and meaning and are good for research. So, it's good if we want to know more deeply about Adele's songs.
